#### **Discipline Panel**

Bowls Surrey is seeking to recruit a group of volunteers to be available to sit on the above Panels as and when required. Full details of what is involved and what skills are required have been sent to club secretaries and will be posted on the SCBA and SCWBA websites.

#### **Club Constitutions**

I would first like to thank clubs for engaging in this important exercise. This was a mammoth task to check over 100 constitutions. There were five main areas of concern, they are: Affiliations – Discipline – Equality and Diversity – Safeguarding – Exceptional Circumstances. Clubs are now busy updating their documents in readiness to put to their AGM's. We were pleased to receive positive feedback from clubs and it's good to know that at the end of the day Surrey's clubs will be legally secure.

#### **Bowls Surrey Questionnaire**

Once again thanks to the 101 clubs who responded. Because of other pressing work we haven't been able to carry out a full analysis of the data, but I can report some of the more interesting results. 95% of clubs are mixed – 86% clubs run recruitment campaigns, with 52% signing up for Bowls England 'Bowls' Big Weekend – 56% of clubs prefer a face to face AGM – 76% clubs would prefer the county to have one organisation – we asked clubs if they preferred one combined area meeting 30 with 36 preferring each area to have its own meeting, as you will have gathered not all clubs answered this question – 87% clubs have their own websites and 59% of clubs are interested in setting up their own matches using the County Match System.
