This is the highest honour a player can hold within the County. The primary role of the President is to be the figurehead and main representative for all aspects of Bowls Surrey that come under the banner of SCWBA, during his period in office.	
Who will I work with?	 Bowls Surrey Management Committee, officers especially (Administrator, General Secretary, Match Secretary, her Vice President, plus those on other Committees as required.
What will I do?	 Attend all SCWBA matches. Attend Bowls Surrey matches. Attend and support Johns Trophy Manager & Team. Attend and support Phyl Hill games. Attend County Quarter and Semi-finals. Attend County Finals Day and present trophies. Present Awards to recipients. Arrange County President's Day. Attend County Dinner, present trophies. Attend Bowls Surrey Management Committee meetings and AGM Attend Bowls England Championships to support the players. Ensuring attendance for the Players Badge presentation and Trophy (if won). Ensure that SCWBA and Bowls Surrey standards and protocols are upheld. Always wear County uniform when on duty.
How much time will I need to give?	 It is difficult to say, as it will vary from year to year, however, it will be very time- consuming and tiring.
What do I need to do this role?	 To be approachable and friendly Excellent communication skills – verbal and written Well organised and disciplined
What are the benefits and how will you support me?	 Chance of making a vital difference to the County and the players within it Being part of a team The Bowls Surrey Board will agree an allowance, which the President may use any way she wishes. It is to be noted, that no other expenses may be claimed. The Bowls Surrey Board will agree an allowance for attending the Bowls England Championships.
