<p>What will I do?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend all SCWBA matches. • Attend Bowls Surrey Celebration matches where possible. • Responsible for Matches that the President cannot attend. • Responsible for the County Flag. • Attend and support Johns Trophy Manager & Team. • Attend and support Phyl Hill Trophy games. • Attend as many of County Quarter and Semi-finals. • Attend County Finals day. • Attend the Presentation of Awards to recipients. • Attend Annual County Dinner • Attend Bowls England Championships to support the President (Not obligatory). • Ensure that SCWBA and Bowls Surrey's standards and protocols are upheld. • Always wear County uniform when on duty. • Arrange with Match Secretary in August, matches required for her Presidential year
