President and Vice President Information Sheet

The following information is to help those who wish to join the Presidential ladder and those who are already on it, in terms of allowances and expenses that are given and paid and responsibilities.

This document is to be used in conjunction with the appropriate role description, which can be found on the Bowls Surrey website.

It should be noted that Bowls Surrey do not cover all expenses that the President and Vice President incur. It is down to each person to decide how much they wish to spend whilst in that office on "top rink prizes, President's Day, etc", bearing in mind that the Bowls England Championships allowance is included. It is recommended that they hold a raffle on President's Day to help with the costs.

President

Shall be able to play in any match arranged by the County Match Secretaries free of charge. (excluding Past Presidents matches).

Shall be able to claim the current mileage allowance as determined by the Board (43p a mile @ 1 April 2024) for any official duty outside of the county excluding the first 20 miles.

Shall receive a sum of money based on affiliation numbers and number of County friendlies, President's and Bowls Surrey matches (10% of Bowls Surrey affiliation fees plus, for whichever President has more matches, £25 for each additional match @ 1 April 2024).

Should the President be unable to attend any days of the Bowls England Championships and the Vice President or another County Representative attends on those days in their place, an amount determined by the Board shall be deducted and passed to the Vice President or County Representative, as appropriate.

Shall be able to attend the County Dinner with partner and two honoured guests free of charge.

Limited other expenses may be claimed as determined by the Board.

Shall be presented with a commemorative shield at the end of their term in office at the County AGM.

Vice President

Shall be able to play in any match arranged by the County Match Secretaries free of charge. (excluding Past Presidents matches).

Shall be able to claim the current mileage allowance as determined by the Board (43p a mile @ 1 April 2024) for any official duty outside of the county excluding the first 20 miles.

Shall be able to claim the current mileage allowance as determined by the Board (43p a mile @ 1 April 2024) for attending any Leopard Award presentations.

If attending the Bowls England Championships as a result of the President being unable to, a daily allowance shall be given, the amount shall be determined by the Board.

Limited other expenses may be claimed as determined by the Board.
