Umpires Corner - Questions I have been asked this month

Question - When does 'possession' transfer to the next player.

Answer - 13.2 **As soon as each bowl comes to rest**, possession of the rink will transfer to the opposing player or team after allowing time for marking a toucher as soon as it comes to rest.

Question - The jack is in the ditch and the player delivers the next bowl 'aiming' to and successfully landing on the jack. Is their bowl a toucher?

Answer - 14.3 **No bowl will become a toucher** if it plays onto, or comes into contact with, the jack when the jack is in the ditch.
