- Elected at AGM to serve for a three-year period
- May stand for re-election

Responsibilities

- Attend Board meetings
- Liaise with other Board members over matters that arise outside of Board meetings
- Update Bowls Surrey Constitution, as necessary
- Liaise with clubs to ensure that their constitutions meet Bowls England and Bowls Surrey Regulations
- Consult Disciplinary Officer re Bowls England Regulation 9, as necessary
- Liaise with other officers re Policies, Rules and Role Descriptions, as necessary
- Keep Policies, Rules and Role Descriptions up to date
- Liaise with IT Coordinator to publish the Bowls Surrey Constitution, Policies, Rules and Role Descriptions and Club constitutions on the website
- Keep master copies of Bowls Surrey Constitution, Policies, Rules and Role Descriptions and latest copies of Club constitutions
- Endeavour to see that activities and operations comply with Bowls Surrey policies
- Attend AGM and any Special General Meetings

Time Required

- Unquantifiable time for keeping Constitutions, Policies and Rules up to date
- Attend three, possibly more, Board meetings a year
